Letter from the Director

Dear Friends,

What a year!

The past year was one of transition and change as Value Education Trust revisited its vision and emerged out with a new mission statement, new products, new projects, a new website and most of all, a powerful vision for empowering children from disadvantaged backgrounds to excel in their life and work.

Yes, we struggled during the COVID 19 pandemic with financial stress and abrupt termination of on-field projects threatening to erode our very fabric. Even though Value Education Trust has been in operation since 1992, we had made a major focal shift in 2018 following the heavy floods that havocked Kerala.

The training sessions for teachers and parents in schools and colleges gave way to classroom sessions for children in community centres and government/aided schools. Despite the restrictions posed by the COVID 19 pandemic to engage in field work, we were able to take small strides forward towards achieving our vision.

Here are the significant developments during the past year:

- Our 'Bring Back a Smile' campaign provided essential food supplies and hygiene kits to 1000 families of unskilled daily-wage labourers.
- Hardcopies of the first 4 activity workbooks for kids for one of our causes were published.
- The teacher's handbook (in Malayalam) comprising of 25 lessons for imparting character education to children was published.
- Over 50 children participated in our career guidance sessions and 25 of them appeared for a psychometric test and personal counselling to identify their best-suited careers.
- The curriculum and content of workbooks for the character education project of children was prepared.

For those of you who have not visited our website yet, here are our leading causes:

1. Character formation of children
2. Whole-brain development of children
3. Mathematical proficiency of children
4. Academic and professional excellence of children

We are grateful to each of you for partnering with us in bringing sustainable impact on the lives of children from disadvantaged backgrounds in India. We are aware of the herculean need for building character and academic competency in these precious children. However, alone we can do so little...but together, we can do so much!

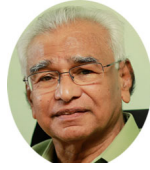

Our Projects

Character Education



Our character education project involves training and mentoring children to develop their personal, character and work values. Its goal is to prepare children to be virtuous and responsible citizens.

We have developed a teacher's handbook to impart character education through stories, activities and review games. The manuscripts for activity workbooks have been prepared.

Whole-brain Development using Abacus



We train children of 10 to 12 years to use and visualise the abacus tool to develop their learning skills such as listening, concentration, observation, retention and recall, visual memory, discipline, and confidence.

We have developed the curriculum and workbooks for the first level of Abacus learning.

Development of Mathematical Proficiency



We train children of 13 to 14 years to apply Vedic Math techniques to achieve better performance in school Maths. Children who use Vedic Maths can solve problems 10-15 times faster than those using standard methods.

A batch of children belonging to flood-hit areas of Alleppey District in Kerala could complete only one level of training due to the COVID 19 crisis.

Academic and Professional Excellence



We train children of 14 to 15 years to build their soft, study, life, and career skills to achieve excellence in school and work environments.

25 children appeared for a psychometric test that assessed their aptitude and interests. This was followed by individual career counselling sessions that provided guidance to select the right stream and move toward their most suitable career path.
