Dear Friends,

The year 2021-22 has been an action-packed year for VET. While on the one hand, we made definite progress in spreading our wings across our state of Kerala, we also spent considerable time and effort to improving the systems and structures within the organisation.

The projects, whole-brain development of children of 10-12 years and development of mathematical proficiency in children of 13-14 years are ready for implementation in two schools, one in Ernakulam and the other in Pathanamthitta District of Kerala. We are privileged to partner with the Sacred Heart College, Thevara, Ernakulam in training their NSS volunteers as teachers to impart training to the children in a school in Ernakulam.

We are nearing the completion of the pilot version of the project, Career oriented guidance and counselling for children of 14-15 years belonging to a flood hit region in Alleppey District. Two schools in Ernakulam district have been selected to implement the project this year.

We will equip and empower 130 children this year to not only achieve excellence in their life and work but also become virtuous and responsible citizens of our Nation.

All our projects are pitched for developing the skills of children of 10-15 year and are hinged on activity-based learning. Our inhouse product development team has designed and developed the handbooks and workbooks for each of our projects. Our master trainers are certified by the National Skill Development



Corporation, Govt. of India to train children in using the abacus tool and Vedic maths techniques. This adds credibility to our resource materials.

The covid 19 pandemic continued to wreak havoc on people's lives, especially unskilled daily-wage labourers. We provided dry rations and hygiene kits to such families living in the flood hit areas of Ernakulam and Trivandrum district. 1024 dry-ration kits and 911 hygiene kits were distributed. 1030 families in 13 villages were impacted. We are grateful to our partners and supporters, who made this possible.

We also ran a successful online campaign on our website that gave information about emergency services in Kerala, including hospitals, ambulances, RT-PCR centres, oxygen refill centres and meal services.

We are grateful to each of you for having stood by us this past year. We look forward to the year ahead with great hope and anticipation. We believe in the power of education to bring transformation in the lives of our precious children. But, alone, we cannot accomplish it. Together, we can!

Value Education Trust serves children belonging to underresourced families in Kerala.

We help enhance the child's learning skills and mathematical proficiency and provide access to career guidance and counselling that help them choose professions based on their aptitude, competency, and skills.

We empower children for their best-fit careers and build sustainable models for community transformation with a model tested among 200 school children and improved upon through its learning.



# **Our Core Objectives**

- To guide the character formation of underprivileged children of 10-14 years.
- To improve the basic numeracy and learning ability of underprivileged children of 10-12 years.
- To improve the advanced numeracy skills of underprivileged children of 13-14 years.
- To improve the academic performance of underprivileged children of 10-14 years.
- To guide underprivileged children of 14 years to choose their best-suited career based on their aptitude, competency, and skills.

## Ready to Better their Learning Abilities!

Thirty children of grade 5 from disadvantaged family background, studying at St. Thomas Girls High School in Thevara, Ernakulam and 15 girls from a similar background, studying at Balikamadom school, Thirumoolapuram, Tiruvalla have been selected to participate in our project, "Whole-brain Development Using the Abacus Tool".

Learning to use the abacus will help the children enhance their skills of visualisation, listening, concentration, logical reasoning, memorising, and recalling, along with developing superior mental arithmetic abilities.



# Giving Wings to the Dreams of Our Children!

Ten students of grades 11 and 12 belonging to the flood-hit areas of Pattathanam and Kalangara in Edathua village of Alleppey District will complete a 10-month long project, called "Skilling for Academic and Professional Excellence" in June.

In addition to developing their soft, life, study, and career skills, they attended a psychometric test that assessed their personality, interests, and aptitude. The test was followed by individual sessions of career counselling which helped them to select their best-suited stream or subject and move toward the most suitable career path.

Furthermore, five of them are being given entrance coaching support that will help them crack competitive exams for professional degrees. We plan to implement a similar project in Ernakulam district and will include 30 children in it.

# Math Geniuses in the Making!!

Thirty-five children of grade 8, will start attending Vedic Maths classes in June this year, as part of the project, "Developing Mathematical Proficiency". The children belong to three areas namely the flood prone Puratheparampu colony in Eruvellipra, Tiruvalla in Pathanamthita District, Balikamadom Girls high School, a government aided school in Thirumoolapuram, Tiruvalla and St Thomas Girls High School, also a government aided institution in Thevara, Ernakulam.



By learning Vedic Maths techniques, they become enabled to do complicated calculations mentally and solve problems 10-15 times faster than those using standard methods. The ability to do mental calculations quickly will be a significant advantage when they take competitive exams after grade 12.

### Bringing Back a Smile on our People's Faces!

Through the project, 'Feed The Needy', we responded to the COVID 19 crisis that crippled people who are unskilled and survive on daily wages to meet their family's day to day needs.



We provided dry ration kits and hygiene kits to 1030 families living in the flood-hit areas of Ernakulam and Trivandrum district. A total of 74 donors made this possible.








### Our Team, Trained and Certified!
